

FREEDOM SCHOOL DISTRICT

To the inhabitants of the school district in the town of Freedom, County of Carroll, State of New Hampshire, qualified to vote on school district affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet in the Freedom Elementary School on Monday, **March 12, 2018** at 7:00 p.m. (**Note: Snow date determined by the School District Moderator.**) to act upon the following subjects:

ARTICLE 1. To see if the school district will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of **\$3,509,991** for the support of schools, for the payment of salaries for school district officials and agents, and for payment of statutory obligations of the district. (The school board recommends this appropriation.)


ARTICLE 2. Shall the voters of the school district adopt a school administrative unit budget of **\$680,886** for the **2018-2019** school year in which **\$175,622** is assigned to the school budget of this school district? (The school board recommends this appropriation.)

This year's adjusted budget of **\$669,593** with **\$172,709** assigned to the school district budget will be adopted if the article does not receive a majority vote of all the district voters in this administrative unit.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the school district will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of up to **\$50,000** to be added to the previously established School Building Maintenance Capital Reserve Fund with said funds to come from the June 30, 2018 unreserved fund balance available for transfer on July 1, 2018 and no amount is to be raised from taxation. (The school board recommends this appropriation.)

ARTICLE 4. To see if the school district will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of up to **\$20,000** to be added to the previously established School Bus Capital Reserve Fund with said funds to come from the June 30, 2018 unreserved fund balance available for transfer on July 1, 2018 and no amount is to be raised from taxation. (The school board recommends this appropriation.)

ARTICLE 5. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting. Given under our hands this **12th** day of February **2018**.
