Lastly, we are still working on some sort of parent survey to find out what kinds of ideas are out in the community the PTA can be working on.

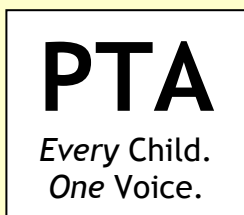
